This certification includes satisfaction of the requirements under the FDA, FSMA and LGMA (California Leafy Greens Marketing Agreement) as well as those of the USDA under OFPA and PACA, including the AMS enforcement of the restriction on fumigation/ionization by products.

To validate claims of regulatory compliance of our gloves, Eagle's proprietary Delta Zero™ program with third-party laboratory testing verifies Eagle nitrile gloves (lot number listed above) have been tested and passed the highest level of glove safety quality standards and performance - testing for the absence of unsafe chemicals, microbial contamination, herbicides, pesticides, fungicides or any chemical that may be considered a food contaminant or adulterant as per the Food Drug and Cosmetic Act.

Though single-use gloves are not commonly a Critical Control Point in most food safety programs, Eagle Protect PBC has elected to incorporate enhanced safeguards beyond the basic FDA or USDA requirements set forth in regulations mentioned above. Eagle's Delta Zero™ process addresses a wide range of hazards to mitigate glove risks to glove wearers, and ensures the safety of handling organic products and brand reputation of companies purchasing Eagle gloves.
